

The Community Eligibility Provision Creates *Hunger-Free Schools*

What is the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP)?

The Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) was established in the federal *Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010* to allow high-poverty schools to offer school meals to all students at no charge; thereby increasing access to school meals, improving learning, and reducing food insecurity.

Why is Access to School Meals Important?


Approximately 20% of all U.S. households with children are food insecure – meaning they do not have adequate access to the food they need to live a healthy life. Food insecurity is linked with poor health outcomes as well as academic and behavioral problems in children. School meal programs reduce food insecurity and CEP expands access to these meals.

How Does the Community Eligibility Provision Work?

Schools currently collect and process individual applications to determine eligibility for free or reduced-price school meals. In contrast, with the Community Eligibility Provision, eligibility for free school meals is determined at the school or district level by using existing data on the number of students that are in foster care or Head Start, are homeless, migrant or living in households that receive SNAP (food stamps), TANF cash assistance, or similar benefits.

Are Maryland Schools Utilizing the Community Eligibility Provision?

In the 2015-2016 school year, 227 Maryland schools participated in the Community Eligibility Provision and as a result, more than 97,000 students attended a Hunger-Free School. However, more than 160 additional schools in Maryland are eligible to elect the Community Eligibility Provision, including the entire schools districts of Allegany, Dorchester, Kent, and Wicomico counties. The following table lists the schools that are CEP-eligible but not enrolled. Interested schools should contact their Food and Nutrition Services Department to sign-up.

NOTES

ISP% = The percentage of students that are in foster care or Head Start, are homeless, migrant or living in households that receive SNAP (food stamps), TANF cash assistance, or the Food Distribution on Indian Reservation benefits. To qualify for CEP, a school or group of schools must have an Identified Student Percentage (ISP) of at least 40%. Grouping allows for schools with an ISP below 40% to still participate.

CEP% = The percentage of school meals served that will be reimbursed by the federal government at the highest "free meal" rate. The remaining meals are still reimbursed by the federal government, but at the lower "paid meal" rate.
