- Apply for D-SNAP (Disaster Supplemental Nutrition Assistance) - a 30 day food benefit for eligible storm victims not already receiving SNAP/FSP/Food Stamps benefits
- Pick up perishable and nonperishable foods donated by the Maryland Food Bank while supplies last
- Apply for Food Supplement Program (formerly known as the Food Stamp Program) and Energy Assistance
